Procedures for J-Alert on Ballistic Missile Launch

If a ballistic missile is launched and is expected to affect our area, the Japanese Government will immediately send an emergency information on the ballistic missile launch. The Government will instruct to evacuate into a building via cell phones and TVs through J-Alert (National Instantaneous Warning System).

In the event of J-Alert, DIA will instruct students to calmly follow the procedures below:

【Actions to take depending on students' location】

<In case students are outside of a building >

- Evacuate to inside, or basement, of a building when possible.
- In case there is no building or house around, hide behind firm structure, or lie down on the ground and protect own head.

<In case students are inside of a building >

- Stay far from windows, or go into a room with no window.
- Follow the instructions from school announcement.

【Actions to take depending on situation/time】

<In case the alerted area includes Kyoto Pref. and/or adjacent prefectures >

- Before leaving home to school; stay home (DIA will provide further instruction)
- On the way to/from school; go home, to school, or near-by building/firm structure.
- During school time; follow evacuation instruction by school.

< In case the alerted area does not include Kyoto Pref. and/or adjacent prefectures >

- Continue as usual.
