What's in the course?

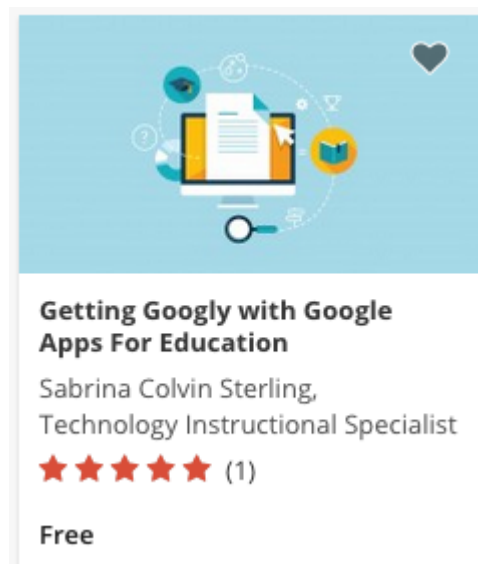
1. Over 46 lectures and 1.5 hours of content!
